DEMOLITION GUILDLINES:	INSPECTION RECORD:		

- All utilities shall be properly disconnected and inspected prior to the start of any demolition.
- A utilities and site inspection by the Clyde Hill Building Inspector must be performed prior to demolishing any building. Certification of oil tank removal and asbestos removal required. (If applicable)
- Work shall be performed without creating hazardous conditions on the property involved or in the public right-of-way.
- Debris shall be removed from the premises and the surrounding area, and all necessary clean-up work shall be completed within 30 days of issuance of this permit.
- The Clyde Hill Building Inspector shall be called for an inspection of the premises immediately following the completion of demolition and cleanup.
- Dirt, mud, rocks and/or debris of any kind resulting from the demolition shall be removed from the street at the expense of the applicant. The Building Official may require a cash bond for this purpose.
- During demolition, all natural contours shall be maintained to the
 extent that natural drainage flow from or onto any adjacent property or
 rights-of-way shall not be disrupted, blocked, increased, redirected, or
 otherwise made detrimental to the use or maintenance of adjacent
 properties and rights-of-way.
