### Solid Waste Rates

In May the Council approved an eight (8) year solid waste contract with Republic Services. The new contract was effective July 1st. The old contract had artificially held down rate increases related to the decline in value of recycling products for resale by Republic Service. The new contract had a one-time adjustment in rates of 11%. There is no annual increase in 2022 and beginning in 2023 there will be annual increases of 3%.

## Accreditation from WASPC

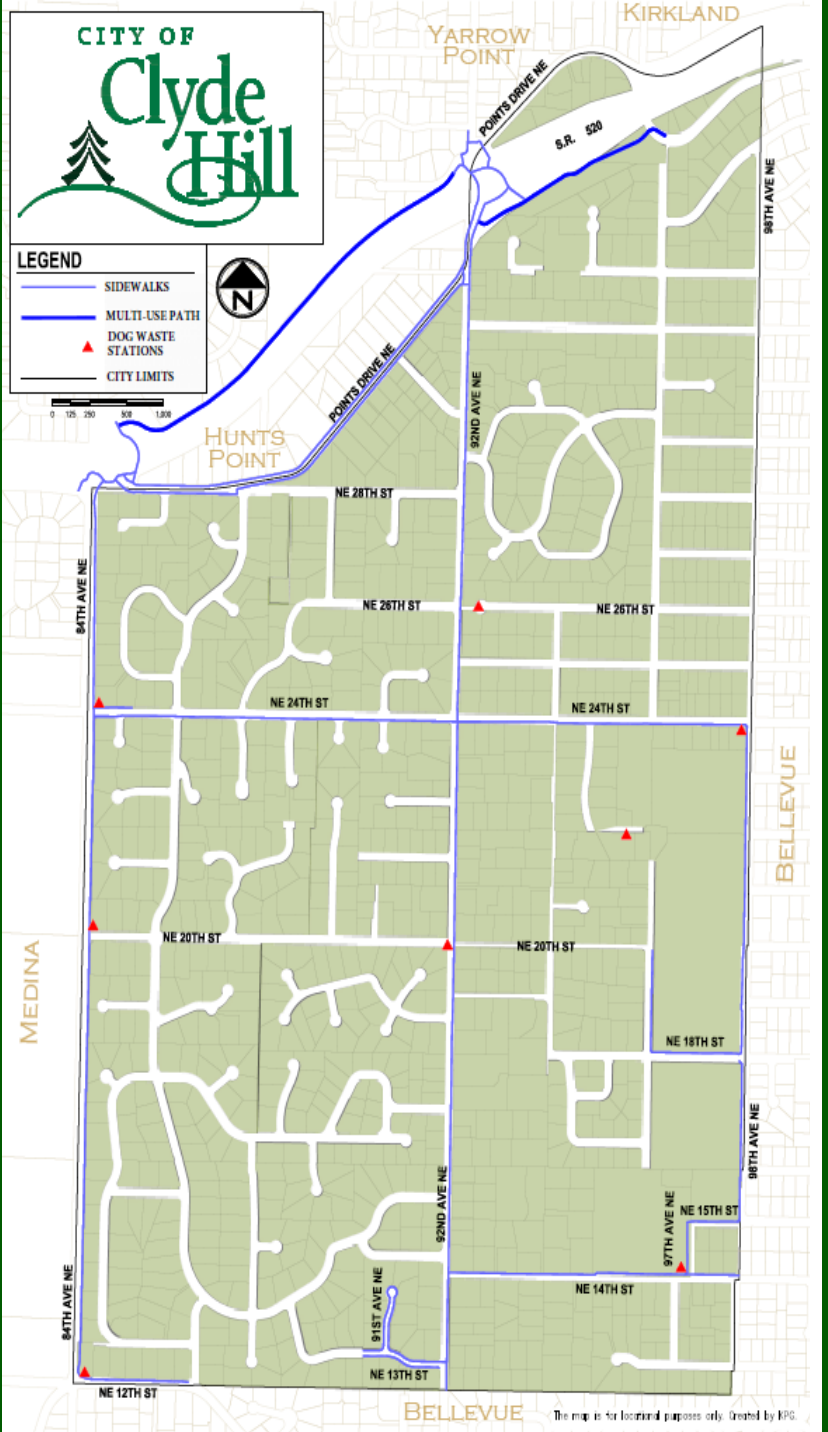
Congratulations to our Police Department! August ended on a high note with the provisional awarding of state accreditation following a "clean onsite" visit by accreditation staff from the Washington Association of Sheriffs and Police Chiefs, or "WASPC". The Clyde Hill police department staff will be attending the annual WASPC conference in November to formally receive their accreditation plaque. The purpose of law enforcement agency accreditation is to professionalize the law

enforcement industry by providing a review process for agencies to be certified as operating under industry best practices and standards.



## Safe Trick-or-Treating

- \* Only give and accept wrapped or packaged candy. Examine all candy before it is eaten.
- \* Make sure children can see well through face masks, or use cosmetics, rather than a mask, to create fun or scary faces.
- \* Adults should accompany young children; always carry a flashlight.
- \* Consider adding reflective tape to your costume.
- \* Keep costumed children away from pets as they may not recognize the child and become frightened and cause harm by biting.
- \* Watch out for traffic. Stay on the shoulder or sidewalk.
- \* Those driving should exercise extra-caution and slow down in case little ones jump out in the roadway.
