Safe Trick-or-Treating

- * Only give and accept wrapped or packaged candy.
- * Examine all candy before it is eaten.
- * Make sure children can see well through face masks, or use cosmetics, rather than a mask, to create fun or scary faces.
- * Adults should accompany young children; always carry a flashlight.
- * Consider adding reflective tape to your costume.
- * Keep costumed children away from pets as they may not recognize the child and become frightened and cause harm by biting.
- * Watch out for traffic. Stay on the shoulder or sidewalk.
- * Those driving should exercise extra-caution and slow down in case little ones jump out in the roadway.
