NOTICE OF ACTION

Through the SEPA review process, the City of Clyde Hill's SEPA Official on December 19, 2022, made a determination of non-significance finding to export approximately 1,500 cubic yards of material to construct a new home located at 8703 NE 21st St., Clyde Hill, Washington.

Those interested in making a comment, an appeal, reviewing the elements of the project, or in obtaining copies of the SEPA determination can do so during business hours at the Clyde Hill City Hall.

Information to appeal the determination on the grounds of noncompliance with the provisions of the State's Environmental Policy Act may be obtained at the City Hall. Any comments/appeals must be submitted on or before January 2, 2023.

COMMENTS

Those interested in making comments can do so by stating them in writing to the SEPA Official, Sara Shrieves, and may submit them on or before January 2, 2023 at the Clyde Hill City Hall. Staff may respond to comments.

COPIES OR REVIEW

Those interested in reviewing the elements of the project or in obtaining copies of the SEPA determination can do so during business hours at the Clyde Hill City Hall, from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.

APPEAL PROCESS

Information on how to appeal the threshold determination on the grounds of noncompliance with the provisions of the State's Environmental Policy Act may be obtained at the City Hall. The notice of appeal must be submitted in writing on or before January 2, 2023, must be filed in accordance with Clyde Hill Municipal Code Section 18.04.260 and should state with specificity the decision being appealed and the reasons why the appealed decision should be reversed or modified.
